QUESTION 38: HOW CAN JESUS BE BOTH TRULY GOD AND TRULY HUMAN?

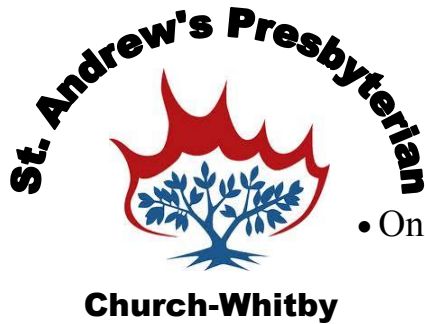
