QUESTION 42: HOW DOES SCRIPTURE DESCRIBE JESUS' DEATH FOR OUR SINS?

ANSWER: Biblical descriptions include atonement by a priest, the sacrifice of a lamb, the ransom of a slave, punishment in our place, payment of a debt and victory over the powers of evil. These express God's great love for the world, reveal the enormity of our sin, and emphasize the cost of our Lord's sacrifice and the sure achievement of his reconciling work.
