**QUESTION 68: WHY DOES THE APOSTLES' CREED EMPHASIZE BELIEF IN "THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH?"**

**ANSWER:** It does so to emphasize that the church is essential to Christian belief and practice. The church is holy in that it is set apart by God to be a chosen people in the world. The church is "catholic" in that it is universal, including all people of all time who affirm the Christian faith. To belong to a congregation is to belong to the holy catholic church.
