CATECHISM for TODAY

The following question(s) come from "A Catechism For Today" booklet published by "A committee on church doctrine, The Presbyterian Church in Canada" in 2005. QUESTION 75: WHY ARE MINISTERS CALLED "MINISTERS OF WORD AND SACRAMENT?"

ANSWER: The word "minister" means "servant." As servants of God, ministers are called in Christ's name to present God's message, celebrate His sacraments and care for God's people. To this office, Christ calls both men and women. The church's task is to confirm the validity of this call, to educate and examine candidates for the office and work of the ordained ministry
