CATECHISM for TODAY

The following question(s) come from "A Catechism For Today" booklet published by "A committee on church doctrine, The Presbyterian Church in Canada" in 2005. Each week, for the 52 weeks of the year, there will be questions printed in the bulletin announcements, taken from the total number of 141 questions in the booklet. QUESTION 72: HOW IS THE CHURCH "THE FELLOWSHIP OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?"

ANSWER: As the church is related to God and to Jesus Christ, it is also related to the Holy Spirit. The Spirit's work is to create fellowship or community. Christian fellowship means oneness and solidarity: The strong have responsibility for the weak; the rich for the poor; the healthy for the ill; and the joyful for those who weep.
