ANSWER: All those who love the Lord Jesus and belong to any Christian church may participate. We come to the Lord's table not because any individual goodness gives us the right to come, but because Christ welcomes us. He loved us, gave himself for us, and invites us to receive His body and blood to our spiritual nourishment and growth in grace. Baptized children may participate if they have their parent's permission, the session's approval, and have received instruction in the meaning of the Lord's supper.
