QUESTION 102/103: WHAT IS THE FIRST COMMANDMENT AND WHAT DO WE LEARN FROM IT?

ANSWER: "You shall have no other Gods before me." (Exodus 20:3; Deuteronomy 5:7) We learn that we are to give the highest honour and adoration to God alone, and not to anyone or anything else.
