(1 Corinthians 11: verse 26)

Every time we participate in a celebration of the Lord's Supper or Communion, we are continuing our affirmation of salvation. That is exactly what the tense of the verb "**proclaim**" states. It is a present, active, ongoing action. We are to PROCLAIM Christ. There it is. The powerful, strong link that connects every believer across the world — past, present and future. We are all proclaiming, declaring as true, saying the same thing about Christ saving us, as we remember Him at the Lord's Supper.
