

***A Worship Minute, (by Tim Archer)...***Paul says: **"Is not the cup of thanksgiving, for which we give thanks, a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf."** (1 Corinthians 10:16-17)
