

A Worship Minute

Judges 7: 1-25, Ephesians 3: 14-21

Our passages this week remind us that God can do immeasurable more than we could ever imagine.

- God says to Gideon you have too many soldiers, if I were to defeat Midian with all of your soldiers they will think it has been accomplished by their strength and not mine.
- In a culture obsessed with numbers and convinced that bigger is better, it is hard to imagine God wanting to thin out the number of soldiers used to deliver the Midianites into the hands of Gideon. And yet this is precisely what He does.
- Sometimes God simply needs a few faithful ones to show the larger group it is all about His workings and not their efforts.
- Can you recall a time in your life where you had very little, felt hopeless, and yet God provided all you needed and then some?
- Have you ever experienced God strengthen you through the power of the Holy Spirit?
- If so, at what point did you realize it was no longer you but the Holy Spirit working in and through you?

As we prepare our hearts to worship God may we be inspired by faithful Gideon and simply follow God's lead.

God is good, and He never leaves us wanting.

May we live lives that proclaim in word and in deed, "praise God from whom all blessings flow."
