

## Listening to God

In the Gospel of John Jesus' miracles are never called "miracles" and instead are referred to as "signs". We are working our way through the 7 signs in John's Gospel and will be looking at sign #6 next. Sign #6 is the man born blind suddenly gaining his sight at the hands of Jesus.

- There seems to be a whole lot of unnecessary commotion and posturing in this passage.
- Over and over again the questions are asked, "*How did this happen? And who is responsible?*"
- The simple and powerful faith of the man is unwavering.
- The man refuses to get all caught up in the foolishness saying in verse 25; "*One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!*"
- What a simple powerful declaration of faith; "*I was blind but now I see!*"

To follow Jesus is to be open to new possibilities and new ways...new sight lines even. May we we open, receptive, and teachable, as we continue to journey in faith and follow our Lord Jesus Christ whatever He may open up before our eyes.
